With almost 500k monthly listeners on Spotify, as well as tens of millions of collective streams, Wasback is definitely one of dance music’s most promising rising talents. At only 23 years old, the producer launched his career by releasing “Magic” alongside MR.BLACK via Hardwell’s Revealed Recordings back in 2016, and made the choice of changing his musical style back in 2020, a bold move that has led to even more acclaim.
